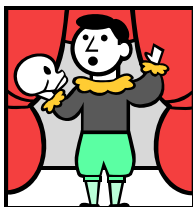

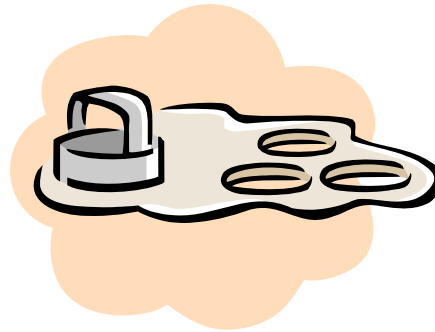

Rachel Robinson) was making about a hundred “invisible” biscuits to feed the ever hungry Webb family. Well, after making about a thousand of these biscuits during rehearsals and performances, we finally convince Mrs. Webb to give us her recipe... and here it is!



Mrs. Webb's Secret Biscuit Recipe

This recipe goes back generations. If you paid close attention, it was made the morning we all met The Gibbs' and the Webb's for the first time. Mr. Webb claims it is his favorite recipe of all time. Just don't eat these yummy concoctions too fast or you will not grow up to be big and strong.

- *2 Cups All Purpose Flour*
- *4 Teaspoons Baking Powder*
- *3 Teaspoons Sugar*
- *½ Teaspoon Salt*
- *½ Cup Shortening*
- *1 Egg*
- *2/3 Cup Milk*



In a small bowl, combine flour, baking powder, sugar and salt. Cut in shortening until the mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Beat egg with milk. Stir into dry ingredients just until moistened.

Turn onto a well-floured surface, knead 20 times. Roll to ¾ in. thickness; cut with a floured 2-1/2 in. biscuit cutter. Place on a lightly greased baking sheet. Bake at 450 degrees for 8-10 minutes or until golden brown. Serve warm.
