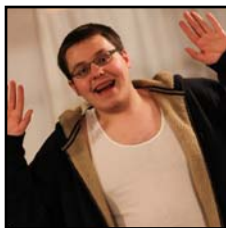
FOOD & DRINK BY MATT SHEEHY
