Well, *IT* has finally arrived!
What is *IT*? Have you been sleeping the past few months? *IT* is the SCS Players new portable stage! It was delivered on October 24th (many thanks to Ken & Sharon Kusch, Pat Sheehy and anyone else who was there to help receive it). On Monday, October 29th it was put up and

used for the very first time (see photos of the new stage in the PHOTO PLAY section of this newsletter). What was it like? Well, I have to say this stage meets all my expectations and even exceeds one! It is sturdy, it goes together well, it is beautiful... and it is *HEAVY*. At least the 4 dual height pieces are heavy... they require three strong people to move them safely, whereas the

single height only needs two. Speaking of moving things safely, the carts we purchased also work very well with moving the pieces—we can safely move four at a time, which is about 900 pounds total. All told, I am very please with result of this project. My personal heartfelt thanks to everyone who helped make it a reality.

In case you haven't heard the good news, the SCSP has purchased a portable stage! **HOORAY!!** Dearly Departed will he the first of many shows to use this new item. We will continue to fundraise to defray as much of the cost of the new stage as possible. This is perhaps one of the biggest purchases in the St. Clair Shores Players history. Our goal is to raise as much as we can toward the cost of the stage. The cost of the stage was **\$5,200**. To date, we have raised approximately **\$3,300**. Just **\$1900** to go!

We are still accepting donations at any time in any amount to help pay for the stage so that we will still have funds on hand to purchase the items need for future performances. Your support in this effort is greatly appreciated, and it will translate into a great resource for the SCS Players for many years to come.


